Medical Examination

Revised paragraph 50 on page 183 of BWC/AD HOC GROUP/39, Annex I.

50. Medical examination of personnel during an investigation, including the taking of any clinical samples, shall only take place with the express written informed consent of the individual concerned. **Examinations shall only be performed by a physician of the individual's choice. The investigation team shall discuss the nature of any examination to be carried out with the examining physician. Examinations shall only seek information of direct relevance to the investigation. Examinations may be observed by an investigation team physician or paramedic. The report of any examination shall only include information directly relevant to the investigation.**
