

CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

The Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment) Order 1997

Made

13th February 1997

Coming into force

7th March 1997

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939[1] and now vested in him[2], hereby makes the following Order:

1 . This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment) Order 1997 and shall come into force on 7th March 1997.

2 . - (1) In article 3 of the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1994[3] there shall be inserted in paragraphs (c)(i) and (d)(i), in each case after the word "exported", the words:

" (except to a destination in Iran, Iraq or Libya or in a country specified in Schedule 3 hereto)".

(2) At the end of paragraph (c) of the said article 3 there shall be added the following subparagraph:

" (iii) any aircraft the immediately preceding importation of which was on a scheduled journey and which is intended for further scheduled journeys;".

3 . For the list of countries in Schedule 3 to the said Order of 1994 there shall be substituted the following list:
